Orthobullets Platform:

Range of free- \$125/year products. This is the most widely used study and review platform for the residents at OHSU.

Free product: Access to “high-yield” topic pages with links to relevant abstracts, 2000+ board questions, online case studies and community videos.

You do not have access to SAE questions/tests. No option to earn CME. No access to additional 3500 questions.

Purchased SAE exams:

\$60 per exam. 15 CME credits +10 SAE credits per exam.

Purchased Peak Subscription:

\$125/year. Access to all of the above free content + 3500 additional questions, monthly milestone exams, video library, ability to take notes and track your progress. Ability to set up different study plans based on needs, will receive daily emails with study subjects and questions based on your study plan.

JBJS Clinical Classroom on NEJM Knowledge+

Relatively new learning platform created by the same team that created the NEJM Knowledge + platform for internal medicine. It is an adaptive learning platform, meaning that questions will be adjusted and presented based off of your performance on past questions, with the goal of making your studying more efficient.

Total of 2800 questions broken into 10 different modules (adult hip reconstruction, adult knee reconstruction, spine etc). The Clinical Classroom can be purchased in its entirety for \$347 with a yearly 150 dollar maintenance fee. Or the individual modules can be purchased for \$147 with a 75\$ maintenance fee. AMA PRA Category 1 CME credit available.

Residents who use this platform have been impressed with the question quality and like the variety of answer types and adaptive learning platform. The explanations are also good and succinct but there is not as robust of answers as the orthobullets questions.

Relatively new resource rolled out by AAOS. The Academy combined the res-study questions with their orthopaedic video library and other AAOS resources into one dashboard. Previously Res-Study questions would be done as a set, previous SAE test. These have been broken up into a Q-bank style platform. While some residents still use this, many have voiced concern about the overall quality of the questions and explanations since moving to the new platform. Having access to the multiple educational resources offered by the academy in one dashboard is helpful and convenient.

Purchased Self-Assessment Examination:

AAOS offers multiple, subject specific, Self Assessment Examinations (SAEs) for purchase. These also come with CME and ABOS credit.

Range in price from around \$100-\$200. Residents and AAOS members are given discounts.
